Departure Procedure

- May 29, 2018 Check-in at 7:00 a.m. at your individual campus (Westlink, Goddard or Valley Center)

Westlink Campus:

- **PARKING:** The buses will use the WEST parking lot for loading/unloading. Please park in the East parking lot.
- All grades will enter through the East Atrium for check-in and luggage tags.
- Flow through the Farm to check-in medication with the nurse (if necessary).
- All students will carry their luggage out the West Atrium doors to be loaded on the buses and then will board the bus for camp.

Adult Staff

The staff will be Pathway Staff and Middle School volunteers and parents who are dedicated to serving and encouraging these children. They desire to see each child grow in their relationship with the Lord. That is why their role is to partner with a small group of Middle School students and help them connect with each other and the Lord through fostering relationships and helping them strengthen their faith foundation in Jesus.

Medications

All over the counter and prescription medication must be administered by the Camp Nurse while at camp. Please complete a Camp Medication Authorization Card. Some over the counter medication is provided as needed with parental authorization. If the student needs to take prescription medication, please complete the following steps:

- Step 1: Fill out 2 Medication Authorization Cards, identically.
- Step 2: Put just enough medication for week of camp in a Ziplock bag.
- Step 3: Put one Medication Authorization Card in bag with medication. Leave 2nd card out.
- Step 4: Morning of camp turn in medication bag and additional Medication Authorization Card to camp nurse.
- Step 5: Pick up inhalers and other medication after camp. Unclaimed medication will be discarded on June 30th.

Emergency

If you need to get in touch with your student as the result of a family emergency, call the Pathway Church office, 316-722-8020 from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm during the week. If emergency is after hours, call the church number to get instructions on how to contact the "Pastor on Call" and they can contact the camp directors for you.

Surprise Your Student

Receiving mail from home is always a big hit!
